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

He has, I believe, agreed to come up to Madras - soon, but I doubt if he would be induced to come back after that. There are more seats which are available & an amicable arrangement can be come to. Just now he has also been upset at the way Pandit Krishna Kant has been conducting himself - will not be induced to give way to him. I appeal to you to manage matters in such a manner that peace & harmony may not be restored between the Special Congress & Pandit Balaram's Mission in the U.P. and a more emboldened nationalism safely led to me. I earnestly look up to you in the matter. Please excuse me if I have written anything that I ought not to have done. I can no doubt you fully appreciate all understand of our family delicate position. Love sincerely

You know the story of 1934. That year I was asked to stand for this to the last. And when my enemies became Muzhi I was then was a speech to stand.
