

Difficult task ahead of Indira, Kamaraj's appeal to Congress MPs

NEW DELHI, Jan. 19 (UNI)—Immediately after the election result was announced, the Congress President, Mr. Kamaraj, appealed to Congress MPs to wish Mrs. Indira Gandhi success in the difficult tasks ahead of her.
