

# Kids In Thousands Cheer Nehru

TOKYO, Oct. 6.—Prime Minister Nehru arrived here this evening after a memorable week-end sight-seeing trip to the scenic spots in the outskirts of the city.

It was a day for children who, dressed in their national attire, cheered the Indian Premier with warmth and exuberance. They turned up in thousands all along the route, waved Indian national flags and shouted welcome to Mr. Nehru.

All through the day with overcast sky and heavy showers, the Japanese citizens shook off their characteristic reserve and defying rain turned up in large numbers in mountain roads, lake side and way side stations to give Mr. Nehru the biggest ovation ever given to a foreign dignitary.

Despite the weather, Mr. Nehru stuck to his schedule and had a cruise in the Ashi lake.

Crackers were fired and trumpets blown when he arrived in the famous health resort Ashi for the cruise.

## AT ASHI LAKE

School children had gathered in large numbers to greet the Indian Premier at the Ashi Lake pavilion, which carried a welcome arch bearing the Japanese slogan 'Kangai Nehru Shu Sho' welcome, Premier Nehru). Nehru's car broke down a few yards from the jetty and the Indian Premier wearing a rain coat and protected by big Japanese umbrellas walked through slush and mud to board the steamboat decorated with festoons and Indian and Japanese flags.

From the boat, Mr. Nehru witnessed an impressive fireworks display.

In the pouring rain several launches moved alongside Mr. Nehru's boat. After the cruise, Mr. Nehru walked on improvised planks of wood laid over the marshy ground to reach his car 50 yards away from the jetty. Harried protocol men rushed to him with umbrellas and rain coat while jostling children rushed towards him shouting Japanese greeting 'banzai' which means 'live for million years'.

## SAMURAI SWORD SHOWN

Earlier at Lake Ashi Mr. Nehru was shown the famous Samurai Sword and Mrs. Indira Gandhi was presented with a painting of Indian village house being built at the lake site under a UNESCO programme.

Mr. Nehru and party motored from the lake to Atami station where a crowd of 7,000 bid 'sayonara' (good-bye).

The electric train by which Mr. Nehru travelled from Atami to Tokyo was in charge of the special locomotive engineer usually assigned to the Japanese Emperor. The engineer took the place of the driver of the train.

In the train, the Japanese ambassador to India, Mr. Yoshizawa showed Mr. Nehru the presents he was giving to his (Nehru's) grandsons.

It was raining when the visiting Premier alighted at Tokyo station.—P.T.I.
