'CR-Abdullah formula only exploratory'

NEW DELHI, May 6 (PTT)—Sheikh Abdullah yesterday said he had discussed with the Swatantra leader, Mr. C. Rajagopalachari, a concrete proposal for resolving the Kashmir question. But it could only be described as "exploratory" in nature.

The Sheikh, who returned here last night after holding talks first with Acharya Vinoba Bhave at Wardha and then with Mr. Rajagopalachari at Madras declined to divulge to newsmen details of these talks saying: 'I must first discuss them with the Prime Minister'.

Earlier at Madras, Sheikh Abdullah had told correspondents that he and Mr. Rajagopalachari had agreed on a solution of the Kashmir tangle.

He said it was an honourable solution which would not give a sense of victory either to India or to Pakistan and at the same time would ensure a place of honour to the people of Kashmir.

The Sheikh said he would stay in Delhi for two or three days more.
