Jayaprakash Narain

MR. JAYAPRAKASH NARAIN is one of the most respectable citizens of India, and it is distressing to learn that his recent utterances have created a situation of danger to his life. Most people in this country do not agree with Mr. Narain's views on Kashmir, as they do not agree with those repeatedly expressed by Sheikh Abdullah. But freedom of expression cannot be denied as long as it does not infringe any law of the land. It will be the negation of a fundamental right to claim that Mr. Narain should not speak out his convictions; it will be more absurd to hope that he should not have a conviction that runs counter to the common conviction.

Mr. Narain's honesty and patriotism are beyond question. Many years of his youth were spent in jail, and he has added to his greatness by placing his convictions above the temptation for power. An evil thought about J.P. is as heinous as the one that led to the assassination of Mahatma Gandhi.
