

# Convention on Kashmir

NEW DELHI, May 26 (PTI)  
—An all-party convention on 'Kashmir and secularism' will be held here on July 1.

The convention is being organised by nearly 140 prominent men including representatives of a number of organisations. Mr. K. D. Malaviya, M.P., is the chairman of the convening committee.

Mr. Malaviya told a Press conference here today that the purpose of the convention was to reiterate that Kashmir was inseparable as any other part of the country and that the accession of Kashmir to India was full, final and irrevocable.

The convention, he added, would also reiterate the view of the people that under no circumstances was there any possibility of reopening the question of plebiscite or self-determination for any part of India, including Kashmir.

Anxiety was increased more by news report that 21 dangerous criminals had escaped from Lima's main prison.

Police armed with light machine guns, were controlling main nerve centres in the city. By early Monday evening calm seemed to have been restored.

On Sunday's disaster, a Government spokesman said the number of dead confirmed so far was 263. Police estimate put the total of dead at 350, while some radio reports put the toll as gh as 500. The dead included three police.

Almost a thousand people were reported to be hurt, and doctors were fighting to save the lives of 20 seriously injured.

## 3 bogies derail, 3 get minor injuries

CALCUTA, May 26 (PTI)—Three bogies of a Bandel-bound local train of the Eastern Railway were derailed shortly after the train left the Howrah station yesterday evening.

The accident, in which three
