

Pak terms on boundary demarcation untenable

MRS. LAKSHMI MENON, Minister of State for External Affairs, told the Lok Sabha on Monday that Pakistan had taken the 'untenable view' that areas in adverse position of India and Pakistan could be exchanged only after the entire Assam-East Pakistan boundary had been demarcated and strip maps, etc. properly signed by the plenipotentiaries of the two Governments. 1.6.64

She told Mr. Laskar that India had been reminding Pakistan that this was a violation of the ground rules. Efforts had been made to persuade Pakistan to agree to the transfer of the Boriabari village to India since demarcation of this particals sector had been completed. The dellinated boundary showed the village of Boriabari on the Assam side of the border.

Mrs Menon told Mr. S.M. Banerjee that in view of this it was likely that the transfer of part of Beru Bari to Pakistan would be delayed.

She said the Assam Government and the Government of India continued to press the Pakistan Government to implement the ground rules and agree to the transfer of the Boriabari village to Assam.

In reply to another question Mrs Menon told Mr. S.N. Chaturvedi: "It is regrettable that the influx of minorities from East Pakistan into India is continuing unabated and they are still being harassed in transit. We are continuing to remind Pakistan to restore a sense of security among its minorities and accord them safe conduct in transit through Pakistan." 40
