Heavier Chinese, Pak concentration on borders: Chavan

NEW DELHI, June 1 (PTI)—The Defence Minister, Mr. Y. B. Chavan, told the Lok Sabha today that Chinese concentration and Pakistan activities on the borders were continuing and Government had taken 'all possible

steps to safeguard the borders'.

In a written answer to Maharajkumar of Vijayanagaram and others, he said: 'Chinese concentration on our borders continues and is now heavier than what it was in November 1962. Pakistan activities on our borders, especially along the cease-fire line and the international border in Jammu and Kashmir and certain areas of Assam and Tripura, also continue'.

In reply to supplementaries, the Defence Minister said as far as his Ministry was concerned, the army and police operations against the Naga hostiles were being 'pursued as before'.

The Defence Minister said the five-year defence plan prepared recently envisaged the strengthening of defence production, improvement of defence communications, and management of the strength of the strengt
