Next day take out the wool and repeat this every night until you feel better. Take a little of this mixture rubbing it in the pit of the earm massage it with the oil. Contine this treatment as often as necessary. The whole trouble is caused by catarrh. Do not wash out or distort your drum. Wool out in lodges in the ear-drum and increases catarrh. There is no disease in the ear. Sniff salt water in your nostrils by scooping it in your hands and smelling it. Bicarbonate of soda is no use. I want you to try t is method.
