NOTE

Record Room experience shows that the labour involved in printing early records is only equalled by the facility with which they are lost sight of when they have been printed. The bibliography below is an attempt to compile a complete account of all pre-Mutiny records of the Government of Bengal which have appeared in print up to the present. The limitations of the list must be recognised. It does not include publications of the Government of India Record Room or of the India Office Record Room, with the exception of certain volumes enumerated in Part III, the contents of which are taken from those Record Rooms, although they have not appeared as Record Room publications. The bibliography does not pretend to go beyond the actual printed reproduction of early records and is in no sense a bibliography of general works on the pre-Mutiny period in Bengal.

The list includes both *verbatim* reprints from records, and abstracts and "press-lists." A "press-list" it is perhaps worth while explaining, is a summary of the contents of letters and does not much differ from an abstract.

It is probable that in the first compilation of a bibliography of this kind omissions will be found even within the limits fixed. It would be of service to the Bengal Secretariat Record Room if any such omissions noticed could be communicated to the Keeper of Records to the Government of Bengal.
