136. It will be seen that, owing to the very unfavourable character of the season, the percentage of collection this year is much lower, and that of remission and outstanding correspondingly higher, than those of the last in Broach.

137. The following table shows the average percentage of expenses of management to realizable revenue and to actual collection of each district, and of all the three districts together as a whole, for the year under report :—

138. It will be seen that these percentages are lower than those of the last year.

139. It has already been explained in a previous report that the lower percentage in Ahmedabad is owing to many of the estates there being leased out and not managed by Talátis. There is no expenditure on collection in these cases.

140. I think that, owing to several important estates going out of management, either a reduction in expenditure or an increase in the Government contribution towards the pay and allowance of the Talukdári Settlement Officer will soon become necessary. Of settlement work proper, there is not now much to be done; and the Talukdári Settlement Officer will, for some years, be chiefly engaged in partition of estates and revision of jama settlement, the latter of which is purely Government work.

LEGISLATION.

141. Under the head of Legislation, I have only to record that what was known as the Talukdári Bill has, at last, passed into law—Gujarát Talukdárs' Act VI of 1888.

142. Nothing further is heard of the Bill for consolidating the law relating to minors, which was referred by the Government of India for opinion, and on which I reported about three years ago.

Procedure under Section 31 of the Gujarat Talukdars' Act.

143. I have, in my letter No. 222 of 3rd April 1889, to the Collector of Ahmedabad, suggested the desirability of laying down some procedure in respect to clause 2 of Section 31 of this Act, which requires the previous sanction of Government to sales of Talukdári lands. This letter awaits the orders of Government.

144. For an encumbrance of Talukdári lands to hold good beyond the lifetime of the encumbering Talukdár, clause 1 of the section above-quoted requires the previous consent of the Talukdári Settlement Officer. One of the objects of this clause is to bring the advice and supervision of the Talukdári Settlement Officer to bear upon the borrowings of the Talukdárs. Now, among others, the two prevailing faults of the Talukdárs are that they are always prone to borrow more than their real necessities require, and that in their eagerness to borrow, they blindly yield to any terms, however injurious, demanded of them by the Bania.

145. In the few cases that have come before me for sanction since the passing of the Act, I have made the following enquiries :—

1.—For what purpose does the Talukdár want to borrow ?

2.—What amount does he want to borrow ?

3.—If the money is wanted to pay off an old creditor, what is the amount of the old debt, and where are the bonds, accounts, &c., of the old creditor ?

4.—What is the rate of interest on the old debt and at what rate the new loan is to be taken ?

5.—What is the approximate net income of the Talukdár after defraying Government jama, &c., and how much of it does he want to set apart for the liquidation of proposed loan, and is it sufficient to liquidate it within a reasonable time ?

146. After making the above enquiries I observed the following conditions in giving my consent :—

1.—If the new loan is required to pay off an old one, it should not, as a rule, exceed the amount of the old.

2.—The interest in the new loan should be as much as possible less than that on the old one.

3.—If the loan is required for marriage, death or other expenses, its amount should only be such as the nature of the occasion and the Talukdár's position and ability to repay would permit.

4.—The land to be written over in mortgage for the loan should be left in the management of the Talukdár on the conditions of his making the stipulated annual payment to the creditor, and on his failing to do so, to be made over to the Talukdári Settlement Officer for management and payment to the creditor. But as far as possible, the management should not be given in the hands of the creditor, as by doing so the Talukdár is cheated and harassed in several ways. Where, however, the land is made over to the possession of the creditor, provision for the payment of the Government jama as a first charge on the land should be made.

5.—Where the loan is taken to pay off an old debt, the bond, &c., of the old creditor should be fully receipted, cancelled and shown to the Talukdári Settlement Officer.

6.—The draft of the bond for the new loan to be shown to the Talukdári Settlement Officer in order to see that there is no condition in it injurious to the interest of the Talukdár.

147. Such, in brief, were the views by which I guided myself in giving my consent. It may be said that all this is too much paternal care, which will never enable the Talukdár to walk without crutches. But I think, with deference, that in the present condition of the Talukdárs this paternal care is necessary for some time, and Government have, in this case, practical political considerations more in view than abstract economic theories.

ESTABLISHMENT.

149. I have already, in previous reports, borne testimony to the diligence with which the members of the office establishment have done the heavy work devolving on them. The work of this office has considerably increased since the establishment was fixed in 1870 on the scale of that of a First Assistant Collector. There are only 3 Kárkúns and a Shirastedár in the vernacular branch of the office, and, unlike the establishment of a First Assistant Collector, they have to do the work of several descriptions of estates in the Collectorates of Ahmedabad, Kaira and Broach. They are able to overtake this heavy work only by hard and continuous labour. The decree kárkún has also much to do. The oldest man on the establishment is Mr. Hathising Ráechand, Head Clerk and Accountant. He is a very intelligent and useful man. If he had remained in the Collector's department from which he was transferred here, he would have, by this time, risen much higher by his intelligence and ability. But in this isolated office he has become a fixture. In consequence of the additional work that will be thrown on it by the new Tálukdári Act, a re-organization of the office establishment will soon become necessary, and I trust that a suitable increase to his pay will be made in this re-organization. The present pay of his appointment is quite fair for a new employé; but his has become a special case from his long service without promotion, usefulness and intelligence. He should receive some suitable personal allowance. The Shirastedár A'zam Shivshankar Bechar is also a useful man in his line. He has some acquaintance with past vernacular correspondence.

2. The number of encumbered estates under the management of the Talukdári Settlement Officer during the year under report was 47 in Ahmedabad, 52 in Kaira, and 8 in Broach. There were also 40 minors' and 5 miscellaneous estates under his management, besides 356 Talukdári villages. Of the encumbered estates, 7 in Ahmedabad, 2 in Kaira and 1 in Broach have been released, while 5 have been added in the first-named district. Three minors' estates were put under the charge of the department, while two were removed from management.

3. Except in Kaira, no advances were made by Government to encumbered estates during the year. In Kaira the sum of Rs. 2,500 was advanced to one estate with the sanction of Government, but of this amount Rs. 2,000 only were expended. The Talukdári Settlement Officer gives a good account of Makhiáv estate and it will be observed that another, viz., Anandpura, will shortly be released, the remaining debt being only Rs. 40. The accounts of the estates of Khoda and Eyáva are not encouraging. The settlement of the several Avania estates with one exception has been effected. The last of the sharers, referred to in paragraphs 37 and 38, appears to be obstructive. The litigation in which the Gángad Estate is involved, in consequence of the claim set up in behalf of the posthumous son of the late heir-apparent, is still pending. The estate is heavily involved, and it will be seen that while it has been under management a large sum has been paid in liquidation of debts.

4. The following table shows the total amount of debts at the commencement and close of the year and the payments made by the encumbered estates in three districts :—

The payments made in Ahmedabad are considerably larger than in the preceding year, but the ratio of reduction of debt has fallen from 6½ to 4½ per cent. (not 11½ per cent. as stated by the Talukdári Settlement Officer in paragraph 15). It will, however, be seen that owing to the accounts having been made up to the end of July instead of March a larger amount of interest (for the 4 additional months) had to be met and this has tended to some extent to reduce the ratio. Moreover, fresh liabilities amounting to Rs. 13,736, were added during the year. In Kaira the ratio remains the same though payments in excess of last year were made. The sum of Rs. 2,000 was advanced by Government during the year and a fresh liability of Rs. 561 was added. In Broach the comparison is most unfavourable, but last year owing to the Thákór of A'mod having been enabled by the receipt of a large sum due to him by Government to clear his estate of debt, the ratio was abnormally high. The reduction of 10½ per cent. in Broach is higher than in Ahmedabad or Kaira.

5. Of the 39 minors' estates 10 are unencumbered, and of these the Mátar and Jhánor Estates in Broach are in a very prosperous condition. The Talukdári Settlement Officer has paid proper attention to the education of the minors under his charge.

6. Considering the unfavourable season, the collection of the Government jama in the Tálukdári villages was promptly effected; but it will be seen from paragraph 96 that in many cases the amount was borrowed for payment. The question of the remission of the balance of the jama due from the village of Návda should form the subject of a separate communication as it is not one which can be dealt with in an administration report.

7. The proposal in paragraph 107 regarding the substitution of stone boundary-marks is also a subject which cannot be dealt with in this place; the Tálukdári Settlement Officer will be requested to submit any proposal he has to make on the subject through the Collector of Ahmedabad and the Survey and Settlement Commissioner.

8. The subject of the execution of Civil Courts' decrees has already been dealt with in the annual report submitted under this office No. 1220, dated 20th April 1889, to Government in the Judicial Department.

9. The suggestion made in paragraph 120 is apparently one which has been dealt with in a separate report submitted to the Collector, and needs no further notice here.

10. The explanation of the Tálukdári Settlement Officer in paragraph 133, regarding the charges of management, appears to be satisfactory. The question mooted in paragraph 140 is however one of considerable importance, and it is for the consideration of Government whether the time has not arrived when the pay and allowances of the Tálukdári Settlement Officer and his establishment should be revised.

11. The Commissioner, N. D., has carefully perused the extra note recorded by Mr. Sheppard when forwarding the report for 1887-88. A terrible state of affairs was therein brought to light, the result being that the labours of the Tálukdári Settlement Officer had in many cases been utterly thrown away. Mr. Propert has not yet had time to make himself thoroughly acquainted with the new Bill (now Act VI of 1888) alluded to by Mr. Sheppard, but will do so shortly.

12. The present is the last report which will issue from the hands of Mr. Pestanji Jahángir, and the Commissioner, N. D., cannot but regret the departure of an officer who has for so long held charge of the office.

Memorandum from the Commissioner, N. D., No. 2473, dated 9th August 1889—Forwarding with his remarks a letter No. 510, dated 31st July 1889, from the Tálukdári Settlement Officer who submits his Annual Report for 1888-89.

RESOLUTION.—There was a net increase of 4 in the number of the encumbered estates of Ahmedabad Tálukdárs which were under the management of the Tálukdári Settlement Officer during the year under report. Five new estates were brought under the Act and one was removed from management, the total at the end of the year being 37. In Kaira the number of encumbered estates was reduced from 52 to 50 and in Broach from 8 to 7. These reductions were brought about by the discharge of the debts by which the estates were encumbered. In Ahmedabad there were 10 estates which, though removed from the operations of Act VI of 1862, were still under management, their debt to Government being undischarged. The number of minors' estates managed by the Tálukdári Settlement Officer was 30, and 189 other estates were for various reasons in his charge.

2. In Kaira the sum of Rs. 2,000 was advanced by Government towards the payment of creditors. In neither of the other districts was such an advance made. The financial position of the estates in the 3 districts is shown in the following table:—

The results of the year's management are on the whole satisfactory. Owing to the exceptional circumstances of the previous year when the Thákor of A'mod was enabled by the receipt of a large refund from Government to clear himself from debt the percentage of reduction in the Broach District does not compare favourably with the percentage of 1887-88, but the percentages for Kaira are almost the same in both years, and it is observed that in Ahmedabad, though the percentage reduction shown in the above table is very low, it would have been much higher than in the previous year but for the additional award made in the year under review. The total reduction of debt was considerably less in the year under report than in the previous year, the decrease being almost altogether in the Broach District, and being due to the large amount refunded in 1887-88 to the Thákor of A'mod. The question of paying off the creditors of the Bodána estates by means of an advance from Government is one which need not at present be taken into consideration as the estates will remain for eight years more under the management of the Tálukdári Settlement Officer.

3. The number of minors' estates under Act XX of 1864, shown in Mr. Pestanji Jahángir's 74th paragraph, does not correspond with that given in his 2nd paragraph. The discrepancy should be explained. The condition of these estates seems to be on the whole satisfactory. His Excellency in Council notices with pleasure the attention bestowed by Mr. Pestanji Jahángir on the education of the minors whose estates are in his charge, and the measures which he has taken to provide for it.

4. The amount of the jama realized in the Tálukdári villages in Ahmedabad, which are under the revenue charge of the Tálukdári Settlement Officer, was Rs. 3,68,297. This collection left an outstanding balance of only Rs. 4,300, and in view of the very unfavourable nature of the season this result must be regarded as satisfactory though His Excellency in Council observes with regret that a large part of the payment was made with borrowed money. The amount expended from Local Funds in the Tálukdári villages seems disproportionate to the realisations from those villages and Government trust that in future care will be taken to give to those villages their fair share of the Local Fund collections derived from them in the form of works of local utility.

5. As regards the financial results of the management of the estates during the year under report it is to be noticed that the total revenue realized including past year's balance in hand amounted to only Rs. 6,11,657 as against Rs. 7,07,499 in 1887-88. This decrease is attributable to the unfavourable nature of the season. The charges also show a falling off, the figures for the two years being Rs. 3,30,218 and Rs. 2,51,570 respectively. In view of the remarks made in paragraph 5 of the review of the Tálukdári Settlement Officer's last annual report this decrease is satisfactory. Mr. Pestanji Jahángir has this year given a more detailed account of the charges of management, and from this it appears that the expenses under this head have remained at very much the same figure for some years, the tendency being rather towards decrease than increase. "Charges of all kinds" include sums expended on the maintenance and education of Tálukdárs and as regards these the Tálukdári Settlement Officer explains that in the case of estates which have large incomes and which are within a short time to be free from their encumbrances he considers it only fair that a more liberal expenditure should be allowed than would be justifiable in the case of poorer and more heavily involved ones. In this view Government agree. The Tálukdári Settlement Officer should be requested to submit a detailed report on the subject referred to in his paragraph 140.

6. During the year the Gujarát Tálukdárs' Act VI of 1888 became law, and its working should be carefully noticed in the report for the current year.

7. His Excellency in Council concurs with the Commissioner, N. D., in regretting the termination of Mr. Pestanji Jahángir's connection with the Tálukdári Settlement Department in the work of which he has taken much creditable interest and which he has administered with a zeal and ability which have more than once obtained for him the commendation of Government.
