

a comprehensive scheme of planting and closing affected areas was drawn up on a report made by Mr. Holland, I. F. S.

In Hoshiarpur the Maili and Dada Chos are being dealt with under the Act. In the Maili Cho the stone-bunds have proved ineffective to control the heavy floods, and the local officers reported to Government that though considerable progress had been made since the Act was passed in afforestation, the time has now come for the work to be carried on on more scientific lines. To this end they recommended the deputation of a forest expert who would be in a position to suggest 'initiate' and supervise measures for the further progress of afforestation.

It has been suggested that Mr. Holland, who drew up the Ambala report, should be in charge of these operations throughout the Siwaliks, and that is the proposal which the Financial Commissioner has recommended to Government.

30. The total number of villages in the Province is ten more than last

year, owing principally to the formation of new estates in Lyallpur and Gujranwala. The total number of land-

owners and share-holders is 3,622,082, an increase of 33,368 since last year, and the number of holdings has increased from 3,082,348 to 3,135,472. The figures suggest that sub-division of holdings is once more becoming a feature of life in the rural Punjab, perhaps owing to the diminution of plague. The average size of a holding is 12 acres, of which 8 are cultivated. Last year it was reported that of the total area held in proprietary right one-sixth was owned by persons who are not members of notified agricultural tribes. This year the fraction is nearer one-seventh. The cultivated area under mortgage has risen only from 11.9 to 12 per cent. of the whole. The heaviest percentage of cultivation under mortgage is, as last year, in Sialkot and Gurdaspur. In this connexion an interesting development is reported from Hoshiarpur. Mortgagees are commonly permitting part of the mortgaged area to be redeemed without any payment being made, the reason being that they are afraid that if they refuse, the mortgagor will redeem the whole area and remortgage a part of it elsewhere on better terms. This is a luminous illustration of the growing value of land.

31. The number of exchanges of land made during the year shows a

considerable increase, while the area involved shows a small increase. These exchanges are generally made to con-

solidate holdings and facilitate cultivation, and are of little importance. The area transferred by gift is little more than last year, but the Deputy Commissioners of Ambala and Sialkot comment on the increase in their districts. In Ambala there is some reason to believe that the form of gift is sometimes used to cloak transactions violating the Land Alienation Act, and all such transactions are investigated.

The value of land is steadily rising. Two years ago the mortgage money per acre of cultivation was Rs. 95. Last year it was Rs. 101. This year it is Rs. 106, in spite of the poor kharif, when many owners were anxious to mortgage part of their holdings. The stress of the kharif scarcity is better reflected by the price realised in sales, which fell from Rs. 124 to Rs. 119 per acre of cultivation. The multiple of the land revenue represented by the sale price of land is shown in statement XXIV. The variations since last year are remarkable. The multiple has fallen in Lyallpur from 273 to 99, and in Shahpur from 241 to 188, owing to re-assessment. The fall in Jhang from 182 to 27 is hard to explain. In Gujrat the fall from 157 to 101 may be due to poor harvests. In Hoshiarpur the fall from 191 to 145 is unexplained. In Lahore, on the other hand, the figure has risen from 332 to 399; in Montgomery from 189 to 242; and in Sialkot from 78 to 102. Most remarkable of all is the fact that the multiple remains the same in Delhi--39--in spite of the appreciation in the value of land which the removal of the capital may be assumed to have caused. The column giving this information was only introduced in the previous year. It will add to its utility if Deputy Commissioners will comment on the variations from year to year.

32. The number of sales of land held in proprietary right was higher in

1911-12 than in any year since 1900-01.

The area sold exceeded the last quinquennial average by 13 per cent. At

the same time the price realised exceeded the quinquennial average by Rs. 12 per acre of gross, and Rs. 9 per acre of cultivated land. Sales by agricultural tribes were more in area than they have ever been since the passing of the Land Alienation Act except in 1909-10. On the other hand sales to agricultural tribes reached 214,000 acres as against a maximum previously of 199,000 and a quinquennial average of 178,000. The corresponding figures for sales among non-agriculturists show that they have sold 84,000 acres, which is a record, while they have bought only 53,000 as against a quinquennial average of 61,000.

The mortgage money per rupee of land revenue rises steadily and now stands at Rs. 89. The area under mortgage to non-agriculturists is the same as last year.

33. The additions made during the year to the list of agricultural tribes

Notification of tribes under the Land Alienation Act. have been made chiefly on the principle that tribes who were omitted originally either on account of numerical insignificance or difficulty of grouping should from time to time be notified if they wish to be.

In Attock the Bati and Sadiqi Sheikhs and in Jullundur the Koreshis were added to the district lists of agricultural tribes. The Dogra Brahmins of Kangra were added to the separate Brahmin group of that district.

Very few applications for notification were unsuccessful. The Bati and Sadiqi Sheikhs, who were notified in Attock, failed to establish their claim in Ambala. The Beldars of Jehazgarh (Rohtak) again applied for notification and their case is under consideration. The claim of the Lahore Brahmins is under enquiry. Various other groups whose applications were considered during the year have since been notified. The status of the Mahtons in Hoshiarpur, who claim to be Rajputs, is the subject of a case pending with the Financial Commissioner.

The most interesting phenomenon at present is the endeavour of those who are not notified and see no prospect of notification to alter their tribal designation to that of a scheduled tribe. Sometimes whole tribes or sub-divisions make the attempt, but more often individuals apply to have their tribal name altered in the revenue records. The indefiniteness of tribal distinctions in the Punjab and the immense variety of sub-tribal designations make questions of status unusually hard to decide. If his application is rejected by the Collector the aspirant goes off to the civil court, where he may obtain a decree against a dummy adversary declaring him to be a Jat or Rajput. Armed with this he confronts the Collector once more—only to learn that as Government was not a party to the civil suit the decision is not necessarily binding on the Collector. Cases of this kind are reported from Ludhiana, Amritsar, Gujranwala, Sialkot, Rawalpindi, Attock and Multan.

34. No special instructions were issued during the year except as regards *benami* transactions. In Rohtak

Rules and orders. where the Deputy Commissioner pays special attention to the subject, a list was prepared of the mortgages sanctioned under section 6 (1) (a) whose period had expired. It is satisfactory to know that in every case the land had been released, and in some the mortgagors had been able to redeem before its expiry.

Sales of small plots of land to menials are freely sanctioned, in accordance with the principle approved in Punjab Government letter No. 47, dated 25th February 1909. The Deputy Commissioner of Rawalpindi anticipates that this privilege will be abused by the menials who will be tempted to act as intermediaries as time goes on. The Financial Commissioner agrees with Mr. Maynard that until there is good reason to believe that menials are acting in this way no restriction should be placed on transfers to artisans. One such in-

stance has already come to light in Kangra. In Muzaffargarh it was found that the provisions of section 21 (a) of the Act were being neglected by the civil courts.

35. District Officers are fully alive to the necessity of watching carefully for attempts to evade the Act.
Evasions.

Such attempts have come to light during the year in 15 districts, while there is every reason to believe, as the Commissioner of Multan observes, that other districts are not free from them. Detailed reports have been sent to the Financial Commissioner for information, and from these it has been possible to obtain a clearer view of the methods adopted to get over the restrictions of the Act. In nearly all cases the system is to put up a dummy transferee who pays the money before the sub-registrar and is entered as vendee in the sale-deed. As Mr. Fagan remarks such cases are inevitable, and it is impossible to close every loop-hole. The refusal of mutation where the real transferee is found to be a money-lender merely delays the inevitable as the dummy then, gets a decree for possession from a civil court to which the revenue officers under section 37 of the Land Revenue Act are bound to give effect. An instance of this is reported from Rohtak. Converse cases are reported from Mianwali in which vendors try to shuffle out of their genuine obligations by raising a false plea that the transaction was *benami*. As the Deputy Commissioner observes between these two extremes the pendulum swings fairly evenly while it is very doubtful whether non-agriculturists will ever acquire by means of such transactions any permanent interest in agricultural land. They are entirely dependent on the good faith of the intermediary whom they dare not put into court.

Another form of evasion which has come into notice lately is sale disguised as gift. Such cases are reported from Ambala and Ludhiana.

A more important method of evasion is the substitution of a lease for a mortgage—the consideration being a lump sum payment. The Financial Commissioners are enquiring into the prevalence of this practice and will, if necessary, report on the matter.

36. Agricultural tribes mortgaged 237,446 acres and redeemed 242,794 acres. Of the total area mortgaged 214,460 acres were mortgaged to agricultural tribes, while only 68,571 acres in Working of the Act Statement No. XXXV.

all were mortgaged to non-agriculturists. Of the area redeemed 267,599 acres were redeemed from agricultural tribes. These figures show that the great bulk of both mortgages and redemptions is entirely in the hands of the agricultural population, and the money-lending class has very little interest in the land. Indeed it is reported from Rohtak that money-lenders are giving up the attempt to acquire land and are relinquishing such pieces of land as they hold.

The sale figures show more clearly a gain to the agricultural classes. Out of a total area of 267,878 acres sold, 83,977 were sold by non-agriculturists, while this class bought 53,440 acres only. Agricultural tribes on the other hand bought 214,438 acres and sold only 183,901 acres. Here again the transactions do not greatly concern the non-agricultural classes. According to statement III the total area owned by agricultural tribes is 33,425,498 acres as against 33,474,002 acres last year. References to districts have however brought out the fact that this statement is prepared from the quadrennial *jamabandis*, and cannot be relied on until all *jamabandis* have been revised. As the statement has only been prepared for the last three years it will not be trustworthy until next year, if then. The results shown by it this year are entirely at variance with those given by more detailed statements and also with the facts stated in the district reports. The attention of District Officers will be drawn to the necessity of scrutinising these figures and correcting them where they are wrong.

37. Revenue cases under the Land Revenue and Tenancy Acts show a decrease. Under the Land Alienation Act there is a slight increase from Business returns. Statements Nos. XXVIII and XXIX.

4,452 to 4,759, while miscellaneous revenue officers' cases have also risen from

37,385 to 39,298. The total number of revenue cases, however, is 161,661 as against 163,532 last year. Two thousand more cases are pending than were pending last year, but the total number of revenue officers employed was only 702, while last year it was 727.

The appellate and revisional work of Commissioners and Financial Commissioners shows 4,359 new cases against 4,424 last year. Four thousand one hundred and thirty-seven cases were decided in the year, and 778 were pending at the end of it, against 626 at the end of last year. Of these, 172 were pending more than three months.

With regard to original cases, the pending file is heaviest in Hoshiarpur, and is heavy in Multan, Gujrat, Muzaffargarh, Sialkot and Lahore. In all these districts, however, with the possible exceptions of Hoshiarpur and Multan, disposals were satisfactory. In Hissar a partition case has been pending since 1906 owing to a multitude of appeals. Land alienation cases are still most numerous in Rawalpindi and are heavy in Jullundur. Seventy appeals are pending for more than three months in the Lahore division and 73 in the Delhi division. Of the judicial appeals in the province 19 per cent. were decided in favour of the appellants, and of the executive appeals 15 per cent.

38. The returns for touring done by Commissioners are for the financial year 1911-12—
Tours of Commissioners.

Delhi.—Lieutenant-Colonel C. M. Dallas, C.S.I., was Commissioner for the whole year and spent 54 days on tour. More touring could not be done on account of preparations for the Coronation Darbar.

Jullundur.—Mr. R. Sykes held charge for 212 days and spent 28 days on tour; Mr. P. J. Fagan for 154 days, of which he spent 77 days on tour.

Lahore.—The late Lieutenant-Colonel C. G. Parsons held charge for 140 days and spent 32 days on tour; Diwan Bahadur Diwan Narendra Nath for 184 days and spent 20 days on tour; Lieutenant-Colonel C. P. Egerton was in charge for 42 days and spent 4 days on tour.

Rawalpindi.—Lieutenant-Colonel F. Popham Young, C.I.E., held charge for 85 days, Lieutenant-Colonel M. W. Douglas, C.I.E., for 27 days, and Mr. H. J. Maynard for 254 days. The last-named officer spent 4 months on tour.

Multan.—Lieutenant-Colonel C. P. Egerton held charge for 248 days and spent 36 days on tour; Mr. C. J. Hallifax was Commissioner for 118 days and spent 49 days on tour.
