Even if we add Rs. 100 to the cost of each well on account of the wood

work, 20 years is an ample period to allow for exemption from enhanced assessment in the case of land irrigated from new wells.

71. In view of the introduction of canal irrigation it might be well to fix the period of Settlement at 20 years. But the area affected will be small and perhaps is not of sufficient importance to affect the general policy of Government.

72. In villages where the enhancement will be over 33 per cent. I would ask permission to defer the excess for 5 years, but if it should exceed 50 per cent. in any village a rise of 33 per cent. might be taken at once, of 50 per cent. after 5 years and the balance after 10 years.

73. The term of the present Settlement expired in Rabi 1913 and the new demand can be introduced as soon as orders are received and the bakh has been made.

74. Orders are required on the following subjects :—

- (1) The proposed assessments (paragraphs 55 to 63).
- (2) Provisional fluctuating assessment for the Khadir (paragraph 64).
- (3) Assessment of the canal-irrigated area (paragraph 66).
- (4) The period of Settlement (paragraph 71).
- (5) Progressive assessments (paragraph 72).
- (6) The date of introduction of the new demand (paragraph 73).



1914, forwarding copies of the Assessment Report of the Raya Tahsil of the

Sialkot District and of the orders that the Financial Commissioner proposes to pass thereon. In reply I am to convey the following remarks of the Lieutenant-Governor.

2. The demand fixed at last settlement was Rs. 3,31,922. It was undoubtedly moderate, but His Honour agrees with the view taken at the time by Sir Denzil Ibbetson that it was distinctly, though perhaps not greatly, higher than that of the adjoining tahsil of Daska. The expiring settlement has worked well on the whole. The present demand is Rs. 3,23,577. It is proposed to raise this by 22 per cent. to Rs. 3,95,000 which represents 67 per cent. of the half net assets, as estimated by the Financial Commissioner, and 10·7 per cent. of the gross produce, and is only about 5 per cent. higher than the Sikh assessment of 70 years ago, when the area of cultivation was very much less and prices of produce only one-half to one-third of what they now are.

3. The considerations taken into account by the Settlement Officer are summed up in paragraph 55 of his report. Prices have risen 50 per cent. and cash rents by at least 23 per cent. The area on which *batai* is paid has risen from 23·7 per cent. to 28·8 per cent. of the total cultivated area. The value of land has risen 150 per cent., and it is now worth 93 years' purchase of the land revenue as compared with 68 during the quinquennium 1892–97. Population has decreased 9·5 per cent. The economic gain from this is more clearly shown in the reduction of the pressure of population on cultivation from 701 to 652 per square mile. The loss in population is due chiefly to emigration to the colonies where the inhabitants of this tahsil hold about 36,000 acres of land, which at Rs. 300 profit per square means an addition to their resources of nearly 4 lakhs per annum. The proprietary body is strong and on the whole efficient, working nearly one-half of the cultivated area; and the statistics of alienation by sale and mortgage show that the agriculturists are holding their own.

The cultivated area remains much what it was except for losses by diluvion in the Khadir. It is believed that there has been a reduction altogether of about 2 per cent., but there has been a corresponding reduction in the revenue demand.

4. On the other hand, the wages of labour and the price of cattle, which is an important factor where over half of the cultivation is dependent on wells, have increased by 50 to 100 per cent. since last settlement. The number of wells has risen by 835 (80 per cent.); but they are said to be unreliable and the supply soon exhausted, and the new wells are often poorly constructed. The average holding has decreased from 8·1 to 6·5 acres, and there is a considerable burden of debt on the land. Communications are bad, though in spite of this the inhabitants of the tahsil manage to get good prices for their produce. Crop failures average 15 per cent. of sowings, but His Honour agrees with Mr. Diack that the reasons for concluding that the proportion of failure has increased considerably since last settlement are not convincing.

5. The Settlement Officer does not attach very much importance to cash rents in themselves, and it is not very easy to see why, holding this view, he should take the rise in cash rents as the main criterion of the enhancement to be made in the demand. He appears to have been considerably influenced by the fact that the result coincided with Sir Louis Dane's estimate of the probable limit of enhancement for the district. The Financial Commissioner, however, has shown that cash rents are really of very considerable importance in this tahsil, and that Mr. Boyd was on surer ground than he thought.

Abstract considerations would justify an enhancement of at least 50 per cent., but it is hardly necessary to say that the case must be approached from the practical and concrete stand-point. Government has to determine, with due regard to all the circumstances, what assessment will be a reasonable one for the state and at the same time fair to the people who are mainly small self-cultivating peasant proprietors.

Mr. Boyd's proposals may to some extent lack logic and lucidity of statement, but they are based on sound local knowledge which is after all the surest guide. Mr. Diack while rightly criticising his methods has accepted his results after subjecting them to a searching test locally, and His Honour has therefore no hesitation in approving the Financial Commissioner's draft orders in regard to the assessment.

6. His Honour also approves of the Financial Commissioner's proposals regarding—

- (i) the provision for the introduction of a fluctuating assessment in part of the Khadir in case the Raya Branch causes water-logging;
- (ii) the assessment of the kharif irrigation from the Upper Chenab Canal;
- (iii) the possible necessity for introducing a fluctuating assessment in villages of the Kalar and Dokandi circles affected by the diversion of the Degh and the Montgomery Canal; and
- (iv) progressive assessments.

7. Proposals as to the term of settlement are deferred. The new assessment will be introduced from this Rabi.

8. The report shows careful and conscientious work, but would have been improved by compression.
