Remittances between India and England.

The transactions brought under this Remittance head fall under three classes:—

(1) Transactions put through the Agency of Government on behalf of third parties, chiefly His Majesty's Imperial Government, involving cash recoveries from or cash payments to them against corresponding payments or receipts in India on their behalf, *e.g.*, recoverable expenditure incurred in India on account of the War Office or the Admiralty, expenditure incurred in England on behalf of Local Funds, Indian States, etc.

(2) Transactions which require final adjustment in the Indian Accounts. Such transactions mostly appear in the High Commissioner's accounts. With the gradual extension of the functions of the High Commissioner as agent to the Government of India, the number of transactions of this nature in the Secretary of State's accounts is gradually diminishing.

(3) Cash remittances from India to England or *vice versa* of funds belonging to India. Under this class come (a) Secretary of State's Bills, (b) Bills on London, (c) Sterling purchases in India, (d) Sterling taken over in London, (e) Transfers through Paper Currency Reserve, (f) Transfers through Gold Standard Reserve. Of these, the first item represents Council Bills and Telegraphic Transfers on India sold periodically by the Secretary of State in London by competitive tender, to meet the requirements of the Home Treasury. The next item "Bills on London" represents drafts on the Secretary of State in London sometimes sold by the Government of India when owing to temporary changes in the current of trade there is a demand for remittance from India to England. The nature of the transactions at (a) and (b) is further explained in notes on page 578. Sterling purchases in India referred to in item (c) are made with the object of supplementing the transfer of funds to the Secretary of State by the sale of Council Bills. The next item, 'Sterling taken over in London' represents the proceeds of sterling loans raised in the London market by local authorities, etc., taken over by the Secretary of State against corresponding payments by Government out here at the prevailing rate of exchange. The last two items represent as the heads indicate, a transfer of funds from the Treasury balances to the Reserves in India or England against a corresponding withdrawal from the Reserve to the Treasury in England or India.

The details of transactions falling under classes (1) and (2) above are given in Account No. 97. The various descriptive heads under which these transactions are shown indicate the nature thereof.

Of the transactions falling under class (3) the Secretary of State's Bills and Bills on London bulk so largely as a normal method of remittance of funds from India to England and *vice versa* that it has been decided to show them in separate Accounts, *vide* Account No. 98. A similar Account has also been opened for sterling purchases in India, *vide* Account No. 98A. The other transactions falling under this class do not require any detailed exhibition and are shown in Account No. 7.

Secretary of State's Bills and Sterling Transfers on London.

The Secretary of State's drafts (called "Council Bills" or Councils") both bills and telegraphic transfers, are in normal times sold by the Secretary of State in London on Calcutta, Bombay, Madras and Karachi primarily to meet the requirements of the Home Treasury, *e.g.*, payments of interest on debt, of leave salaries and pensions purchase of stores for India, etc. The proceeds of the sales are placed to the credit of the Secretary of State's Treasury balances, and any amount in excess of Treasury requirements are placed to the credit of the Paper Currency Reserve or the Gold Standard Reserve when circumstances render this course expedient. The payments of Council Bills in the latter case are met by transfer to Treasury balances of funds from the Paper Currency Reserve or from the amounts held in India on account of the Gold Standard Reserve. In a period of weak exchange the sale of Council drafts is normally suspended and unless circumstances render it inexpedient, sterling bills and telegraphic transfers (called Reverse Councils) on the Secretary of State are sold by the Government of India for the purpose of supporting exchange, the conditions of sales being announced at the time.

Prior to 1922-23, the transactions in connection with Secretary of State's Bill and Sterling Transfers in London were exhibited in a separate Section, 'Section U—Secretary of State's Bills, etc.' These transactions have since been grouped under 'Section T—Remittances'.
