APPENDIX D.

Rules for admission to the Central Provinces Provincial Civil Service.

A.—ADMISSION.

I. Every candidate for appointment, by recruitment, to the Central Provinces Provincial Civil Service must furnish satisfactory evidence—

- (a) that he is a "Native of India" within the definition given in 33 Victoria, Chapter 3, Section 6* ;
- (b) that he is not over 25 years of age, except in the case of Barristers, Advocates and Pleaders, in the case of whom the age limit shall be 30 years ;
- (c) that he is of sound health, good physique, and active habits ;
- (d) that he is of good character ;
- (e) that he has passed the B. A. Examination at a University ;
- (f) that he has passed the Central Provinces (Departmental) Language Examination in Hindi or Marathi. Provided that a candidate whose Vernacular is Hindi or Marathi and who has successfully passed the Middle School Standard examination in such Vernacular shall be deemed to have satisfied this rule ;
- (g) that he has been a resident of the Central Provinces for a period of at least three years terminating within a year of his application for an appointment.

Explanation.—Subjects of Native Princes in alliance with Her Majesty shall be eligible if they fulfil conditions (a) to (g).

Exception.—Europeans who are not "Natives of India," but who have received an education equal, in the opinion of the Chief Commissioner, to the standard required by condition (e) shall be eligible for appointment with the sanction of the Government of India, provided they fulfil the requirements of conditions (b), (c), (d), (f) and (g).

II. No Officer in the Central Provinces Subordinate Civil Service has any claim, as a matter of right, to advancement to the Provincial Civil Service but such an officer, if he is qualified under conditions (c), (d) and (f) Rule I, has passed the Departmental Examination in Law and Procedure by the Higher Standard, and has displayed conspicuous ability, may be promoted to the higher services at the discretion of the Chief Commissioner

*For convenience of reference, the definition given in Section 6 of 33 Victoria, Chapter 3, is reproduced here :—

For the purpose of this Act, the words "Native of India" shall include any person born and domiciled within the dominions of Her Majesty in India of parents habitually resident in India, and not established there for temporary purposes only.

III. An officer of the Central Provinces Police who is qualified under clauses (c), (d) and (f) of Rule I may, on the ground of conspicuously good service, be promoted to the Provincial Civil Service at the discretion of the Chief Commissioner.

IV. Every person appointed to the Provincial Civil Service shall be subject to a period of two years' training, during which his appointment will be probationary only, unless, in any special case, the Chief Commissioner declares such probation to be unnecessary. During this period of training he must pass the Departmental Examination in Law and Procedure by the Higher Standard.

B.—PROMOTION.

V. Promotion in the grades which carry pay of less than Rs. 500 a month shall ordinarily be regulated by seniority, but inefficiency or misconduct will involve liability to supersession. Seniority alone will not, on the other hand, give any claim to promotion to the grade on Rs. 500 a month or to more highly paid appointments.

VI. The Government of India reserves the power to make, in very special cases, direct appointments to offices in the higher grades of the Provincial Civil Service.

C.—DISMISAL.

VII. No member of the Provincial Civil Service shall be dismissed otherwise than on the result of a Judicial or formal departmental enquiry.

*Rules for admission to the Central Provinces Subordinate
Civil Service.*

The following rules regarding the qualifications required of candidates for appointments, other than menial, in the Revenue and Judicial branches of the Government Service in the Central Provinces, have been made by the Chief Commissioner, and are published for general information :—

I. Except in the case of posts to which a European may be appointed, no person shall be admitted to the Government Service who is not a Native of the Central Provinces.

NOTE.—The words "A Native of the Central Provinces" include any person born and domiciled within the Central Provinces of parents habitually resident there and not established there for temporary purposes only.

* * * * *

V. No person, not being already a servant of Government, shall ordinarily be appointed to be a Tahsildar, Munsiff or Naib-Tahsildar, unless he shall have passed the F. A. Examination of some Indian University, or is qualified, under the rules in force, for enrolment as a Pleader of the Second Grade in the Courts of the Central Provinces.

In promoting persons already in the service of Government to be Tahsildars, Munsiffs or Naib-Tahsildars, preference will, as a rule, be given to those who possess the qualifications above described.

All direct appointments to the post of Tahsildar, Munsiff or Naib-Tahsildar shall be on probation, and no person will be confirmed as such unless he shall have passed the Departmental Examination by the Lower Standard in the branches noted below within two years of his appointment:—

IN supersession of Home Department Notification No. 2032, dated the 1st November 1877, the following new Warrant of Precedence for India which has been approved by Her Majesty the Queen, Empress of India, and which has received Her Royal Sign Manual, as also the revised graded list of civil offices not reserved for Members of the Indian Civil Service, supplementary to the Warrant of Precedence, which has been prepared under the orders of the Governor-General in Council, are published for general information :—

To all to whom these presents shall come :

When an officer holds more than one position in the table, he will be entitled to the highest position accorded to him.

All officers not mentioned in the above table, whose rank is regulated by comparison with rank in the Army, to have the same rank with reference to civil servants as is enjoyed by military officers of equal grades.

All other persons who may not be mentioned in this table to take rank according to general usage, which is to be explained and determined by the Governor General in Council in case any question shall arise.

Nothing in the foregoing rules to disturb the existing practice relating to precedence at Native Courts, or on occasions of intercourse with Natives, and the Governor General in Council to be empowered to make rules for such occasions in case any dispute shall arise.

All ladies to take place according to the rank herein assigned to their respective husbands, with the exception of wives of Peers, and of ladies having precedence in England independently of their husbands, and who are not in rank below the daughters of Barons; such ladies to take place according to their several ranks, with reference to such precedence in England, immediately after the wives of Members of the Council of the Governor-General.
