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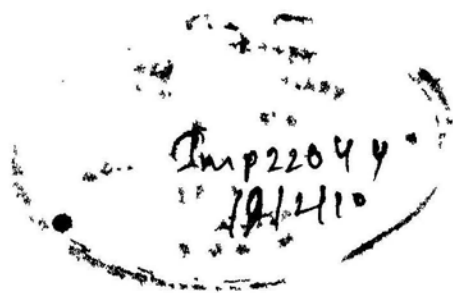

GRADATION LIST

OF THE

HON'BLE EAST INDIA COMPANY'S COVENANTED CIVIL SERVANTS ON THEIR BOMBAY ESTABLISHMENT,

As the same stood on the 1st January 1858.

The Rank of Civil Servants commences from the date of arrival at Bombay of the first Writer appointed in Europe, of the same season of which they are Writers; and, being thus determined, all Civil Servants belong, during the first four years, to Class VI.;—from the fifth to the end of the eighth year, to Class V.;—from the ninth to the end of the twelfth year, to Class IV.;—from the thirteenth to the end of the twentieth year, to Class III.;—from the twenty-first to the end of the thirty-fifth year, to Class II.;—and from and after the thirty-fifth year, to Class I.

The date of commencement of service is that of the Covenant, or of the appointment by the Court of Directors, whichever may be the earlier. This is denoted by the letters c or a in the fourth column.

The letters A, C, G, H, M, P, S, and (p), (1), or (2) prefixed to the names, signify that the parties have passed an examination in the Arabic, Canarese, Guzerathee, Hindoostanee, Murathee, Persian, and Sindee Languages, and the "preliminary," "first" or "second" Examination under the Provisional Rules published on the 14th Sept. 1854.
