GRADATION LIST

OF

HER MAJESTY'S COVENANTED CIVIL SERVANTS ON THE BOMBAY ESTABLISHMENT.

As the same stood on the 1st July 1859.

The Rank of Civil Servants commences from the date of arrival at Bombay of the first Writer appointed in Europe, of the same season of which they are Writers; and, being thus determined, all Civil Servants belong, during the first four years, to Class VI.;—from the fifth to the end of the eighth year, to Class V.;—from the ninth to the end of the twelfth year, to Class IV.;—from the thirteenth to the end of the twentieth year, to Class III.;—from the twenty-first to the end of the thirty-fifth year, to Class II.;—and from and after the thirty-fifth year, to Class I.

The date of commencement of service is that of the Covenant, or of the appointment by the Home Authority, whichever may be the earlier. This is denoted by the letters c or a in the fourth column.

The letters A, C, G, H, M, P, S, and (1) or (2) prefixed to the names, signify that the parties have passed an examination in the Arabic, Canarese, Guzerathee, Hindoostanee, Murathee, Persian, and Sindee Languages, and the "first" or "second" Examination under the Provisional Rules published on the 13th Sept. 1854, and 15th April 1856.

- E.—The Collectors and Sub-Collector of Land Revenue, (except at the Presidency,) draw District Travelling Allowance at Rs. 10 per diem when employed in the Districts, about six months in the year.
- F.—The Judges and Session Judges draw District Travelling Allowance at Rs. 10 per diem when absent from their Stations, visiting Judicial Functionaries under their control : those of Sholapoor and Khandesh draw in addition Fees on the Registry of Deeds.
- G.—The Judicial Assistant Collector, Sattara, draws Travelling Allowance at Rs. 10 per diem when in the Districts, for four months, or longer under fresh sanction of Government.
- H.—The Senior Assistant and Assistant Judges draw District Travelling Allowance at Rs. 10 per diem when visiting Judicial Functionaries under their control, and Fees on the Registry of Deeds.

 * Vide G. G. O. No. 527, dated 2nd May 1855. supersession of the Table of Precedence for India prescribed in January* 1855, is published for general information:—

VICTORIA R.

VICTORIA, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Queen, Defender of the Faith. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting.

Whereas it hath been represented unto Us that it is advisable to regulate the Rank and Precedence of persons holding Appointments in the East Indies, in order to fix the same, and prevent all disputes: We do hereby declare that it is Our Will and Pleasure that the following Table be observed with respect to the Rank and Precedence of the persons hereafter named:—

The Governor General, or Governor General for the time being.

The Governor of Bengal.

The Governor of Madras.

The Governor of Bombay.

The Governor of Agra.

The Governor of any Presidency which may be hereafter formed in India.

The President of the Council of India.

The Lieutenant Governors of any of the Presidencies in India, according to priority of appointment.

The Chief Justice, Bengal.

- The Bishop of Calcutta.
- The Chief Justice, Madras.
- The Bishop of Madras.
- The Chief Justice, Bombay.
- The Bishop of Bombay.
- The Commander in Chief in India, when also a Member of the Supreme Council.
- Members of the Supreme Council of India, according to priority of appointment.
- Members of Council of Bengal, according to priority of appointment.
- The Commander in Chief at Madras, when also a Member of Council.
- Members of Council at Madras, according to priority of appointment.
- The Commander in Chief at Bombay, when also a Member of Council.
- Members of Council at Bombay, according to priority of appointment.
- The Members of the Legislative Council of India, according to priority of appointment.
- The Puisne Judges of the Supreme Court of Calcutta, according to priority of appointment.
- The Puisne Judges of the Supreme Court of Madras, according to priority of appointment.
- The Puisne Judges of the Supreme Court of Bombay, according to priority of appointment.
- The Governor of the Straits' Settlements.
- The Recorder of Prince of Wales' Island.
- The Commander in Chief in India.
- The Commander in Chief of Her Majesty's Naval Forces.
- The Commander in Chief of the Army at the several Presidencies, (not being Commander in Chief in India,) according to relative rank in their respective Services.
- The Commander in Chief of the Indian Navy.
- Naval and Military Officers above the rank of Major General.
- Members of the Sudder Adawlat, according to priority of appointment.
- Civilians, with reference to their Rank and Precedence, to be divided into six Classes:—
- Civilians of thirty-five years' standing, from date of rank assigned to them on their arrival, to form Class I., and from date of entering such Class to rank with Major Generals, according to date of Commission.

Civilians of twenty years' standing, from date of rank assigned to them on their arrival, to form Class II., and from date of entering such Class to rank with

Colonels, according to date of Commission.

Archdeacon, Calcutta.

Archdeacon, Madras.

Archdeacon, Bombay.

Civilians of twelve years' standing, from date of rank assigned to them on their arrival, to form Class III., and from date of entering such Class to rank with

Lieutenant Colonels, according to date of Commission.

Civilians of eight years' standing, from date of rank assigned to them on their arrival, to form Class IV., and from date of entering such Class to rank with

Majors, according to date of Commission.

Civilians of four years' standing, from the date of rank assigned to them on their arrival, to form Class V., and from date of entering such Class to rank with

Captains, according to date of Commission.

Civilians under four years' standing, from the date of rank assigned to them on their arrival, to form Class VI., and to rank with

Subalterns, according to date of Commission.

Advocates General to rank with the First Class of Civil Servants.

Chaplains to rank with Civilians of the Fourth Class, and Majors.

Assistant Chaplains to rank with Civilians of the Fifth Class, and Captains.

All Officers not mentioned in the above Table, whose rank is regulated by comparison with rank in the Army, to have the same rank with reference to Civil Servants as is enjoyed by Military Officers of equal grades.

All other persons who may not be mentioned in this Table to take rank according to general usage, which is to be explained and determined by the Governor General in Council, in case any question shall arise.

Nothing in the foregoing Rules to disturb the existing practice relating to precedence at Native Courts, and on occasions of intercourse with Natives; and the Governor General in Council to be empowered to make Rules for such occasions, in case any dispute shall arise.

All Ladies to take place according to the rank assigned to their respective husbands, with the exception of wives of Peers, and of Ladies having precedence in England independently of their husbands, and who are not in rank below the daughters of Barons; such Ladies to take place according to their several ranks, with reference to such precedence in England, immediately after the wives of Members of Council at the Presidencies in India.

Given at Our Court at Windsor, this Tenth day of January, in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Fifty-seven, and in the Twentieth year of Our Reign.
