It having come to the knowledge of Government that very erroneous impressions are entertained on the subject of pecuniary arrangements referable to the resignation of appointments, the Honorable the President in Council is pleased to give notice, that all such arrangements are prohibited, and that on proof of any appointment, Civil or Military, having been resigned under such circumstances, the nomination consequent on such resignation will be cancelled, and the parties concerned suspended the Service in public orders, pending the pleasure of the Honorable the Court of Directors.

GENERAL DEPARTMENT.

Military Officers in Civil employ will in future apply through the Civil Department alone to which they are attached for leave within the limits of the Presidency.

Applications from Officers so circumstanced for leave beyond the limits of the Presidency must be preferred and disposed of in the Military Department, but in the latter case, the Officer is bound to obtain, in the first instance, through the Civil Department, permission to prefer his application in the Military Department, except in cases of certified illness, when, to obviate the consequences of delay, the latter condition may, if necessary, be dispensed with; the Officer on the day of his making application to the Military Department merely notifying to the head of the Civil Department in which he may be serving that he has so done. In this case the head of the Department will immediately make to Government, through the proper channel, the same remarks in support of or against the application that he would have made had it been preferred through him.

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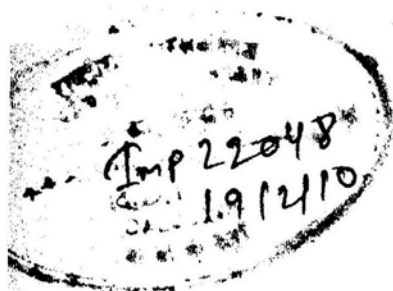

GRADATION LIST

OF

HER MAJESTY'S COVENANTED CIVIL SERVANTS ON THE BOMBAY ESTABLISHMENT.

As the same stood on the 1st November 1859.

The Rank of Civil Servants commences from the date of arrival at Bombay of the first Writer appointed in Europe, of the same season of which they are Writers; and, being thus determined, all Civil Servants belong, during the first four years, to Class VI.;—from the fifth to the end of the eighth year, to Class V.;—from the ninth to the end of the twelfth year, to Class IV.;—from the thirteenth to the end of the twentieth year, to Class III.;—from the twenty-first to the end of the thirty-fifth year, to Class II.;—and from and after the thirty-fifth year, to Class I.

The date of commencement of service is that of the Covenant, or of the appointment by the Home Authority, whichever may be the earlier. This is denoted by the letters c or a in the fourth column.

The letters A, C, G, H, H, M, P, S, T, and (1) or (2) prefixed to the names, signify that the parties have passed an examination in the Arabic, Canarese, Guzerathee, Hindee, Hindoostanee, Murathee, Persian, Sindee, and Telingee Languages, and the "first" or "second" Examination under the Provisional Rules published on the 13th Sept. 1854, and 15th April 1856.
