GRADATION LIST

HER MAJESTY'S COVENANTED CIVIL SERVANTS
ON THE BOMBAY ESTABLISHMENT.
Corrected up to 31st December 1863.

The service of Civil Servants who arrived in India before 2nd October 1860 commences from the date of the Covenant or Despatch announcing their Appointments, whichever is earliest. The service of those who have arrived subsequent to the above date commences from the date of arrival in India of the first Civil Servant of the season to which they belong.—2nd. The rank of Civil Servants commences from the date of arrival at Bombay of the first Writers appointed in Europe of the same season of which they are Writers, and being thus determined all Civil Servants belong during the first four years, to Class VI.;—from the fifth to the end of the eighth year, to Class V.;—from the ninth to the end of the twelfth year, to Class IV.;—from the thirteenth to the end of the twentieth year, to Class III.;—from the twenty-first to the end of the thirty-fifth year, to Class II.;—and from and after the thirty-fifth year, to Class I.

The letters A, C, C, Hin., H, M, P, S, T, and (1) or (2) prefixed to the names, signify that the parties have passed an examination in the Arabic, Canarese, Guzerathee, Hindee, Hindoostanee, Murathee, Persian, Sindee, and Teloo-goo Languages, and the "first" or "second" Examination under the Provisional Rules published on the 13th Sept. 1854 & 15th April 1856.

The letters specified in column 5th denote the date of return of officers from leave : M. C. medical certificate ; P. A. private affairs ; and F. furlough.
