GRADATION LIST

OF

HER MAJESTY'S COVENANTED CIVIL SERVANTS

ON THE BOMBAY ESTABLISHMENT.

Corrected up to 1st January 1869.

The rank of Civil Servants commences from the date of arrival at Bombay of the first Writer appointed in Europe of the same season of which they are Writers; and being thus determined, all Civil Servants belong, during the first four years, to Class VI.;—from the fifth to the end of the eighth year, to Class V.;—from the ninth to the end of the twelfth year, to Class IV.;—from the thirteenth to the end of the twentieth year, to Class III.;—from the twenty-first to the end of the thirty-fifth year, to Class II.;—and from and after the thirty-fifth year, to Class I.

The date of commencement of Service is that of the Covenant, or of the Appointment by the Home Authority, whichever may be the earlier.

The letters A, C, G, Hin., H, M, P, S, Sin., T, and (1) or (2) prefixed to the names, signify that the parties have passed an examination in the Arabic, Canarese, Guzerathee, Hindee, Hindoostanee, Murathee, Persian, Sanscrit, Sindee, and Telooogo Languages, and the "first" or "second" Examination under the Provisional Rules published on the 13th September 1854 and 15th April 1856.

Those Civil Servants to whose names the letters JD are attached are applicants for the Judicial Branch of the Service.

The letters specified in column 6 denote the date of return of officers from leave: M. C. medical certificate; P. A. private affairs; and F. furlough.

In the Column of Emoluments S stands for Salary; AA for Absentee allowance; DA for Deputation allowance; TA for Travelling allowance; SA for Subsistence allowance; T for Tentage; H for House rent; M for Moonshee allowance; CA for Conveyance allowance; and NP for Net pay.
