





## PUBLISHERS' NOTE.

IT has been the custom for a good many years past for the Publishers of THACKER'S INDIAN DIRECTORY to print a foreword to each succeeding volume that makes its appearance. Coincident with the FORTY-FOURTH ISSUE now published, a new departure was inaugurated in issuing a separate volume appertaining to the City of Calcutta only, which has met with such gratifying success that the publication is destined to live. The experiment was made with some hesitation, as the expenditure on such a venture is necessarily large, and although a certain demand for such a work existed, it was by no means certain that sufficient support would be forthcoming to make it financially successful. THACKER'S CALCUTTA DIRECTORY has, however, now taken a firm stand beside the parent volume, and may be looked for annually with the same regularity as has characterised the appearance of THACKER'S INDIAN DIRECTORY.

Turning to the present volume, the most interesting development to be noted therein is the steady expansion that it registers of the Commercial side of Indian Life. Of factories, mines, &c., in 1864, 230 concerns are recorded; in 1875, 730; in 1883, 1,124; in 1888, 2,109. The 1906 issue includes the names of no less than 3,373! The Chief Industries Section of the Directory has proved so extensively useful in other lands besides India that special attention is being devoted to adding to it, and a commencement has already been made in this direction by bringing the Straits Settlements within its scope.

A small, but interesting section now appears for the first time, viz., the Government Departments in England having special functions connected with India, a *résumé* of their duties and a personal list of the leading officials concerned in their working. This information will be found on page 328a.

The growth of Thacker's Directory has been so rapid, especially so during the last few years, that a glance at its history may not be without interest. The first issue was in 1863 and consisted of 512 pages printed in large open style, as compared with that for 1906, which contains 2054 pages of closely printed matter. The Directories that had previously been in circulation were unwieldy and expensive; contained Statistical Abstracts from Official Documents, Geographical Information, Instructions on Gardening, besides other irrelevant matter. The object of the promoters of the present work was to produce a Directory that should be simply a guide to the Professions, Occupations, and Addresses of persons resident in the country, and this object has been kept steadily in view. It was at first known as THACKER'S POST OFFICE DIRECTORY, subsequently as THACKER'S BENGAL DIRECTORY, and in 1885 was re-named THACKER'S INDIAN DIRECTORY. In that year were added the districts in the Madras and Bombay Presidencies and all the machinery of their respective Governments, together with the professional and mercantile classes in those cities, each Presidency having a separate section devoted to it. The Districts of the newly-acquired province of Upper Burma were added in 1887, and in that year also appeared for the first time an Alphabetical List of the principal Native Inhabitants of India.

In 1879 the Trading Marks of the various Tea, Coffee and Indigo concerns were added. This unique feature had not at that time found a place in any other Directory in the world.

It is again a pleasant duty for the Publishers to render their thanks to the public for the information so readily furnished them, and without whose co-operation the task of compiling the Directory would be an almost impossible one.

The Directory is becoming more and more appreciated by advertisers, who find in it an effective and universally circulated medium for the extension of their trade. When it is considered that THACKER'S INDIAN DIRECTORY is in daily reference throughout India, Burma and Ceylon, with a wide circulation in Great Britain, its value as an advertising medium is at once apparent. 
