TITLE FOR EMINENCE IN ORIENTAL LEARNING.

A new title for eminent services rendered by Hindus or Mahomedans in the promotion of Oriental learning. His Excellency the Viceroy and Governor-General directs that in the case of Hindus the title shall be MAHAMAHOPADHYAYA; and in the case of Mahomedans, SHAMS-UL-ULAMA. The former takes rank next below titular Rajas, and the latter next below titular Nawabs.
 The title shall be prefixed to the name of the title-holder.

FUNERAL HONOURS.

Minute guns equal in number to the years of the deceased, not to be fired on any occasion, unless by special order of the Governor-General in Council.
