<p>Rendered valuable service during the Mutiny in furnishing Officers with necessities in the Fort of Futtehghurh, previous to their taking to their boats, and generally affording protection to Christians in his house. He was instrumental in securing the allegiance of several important parties, for which he was recommended for the first class order of British India, and appointed head of the Intelligence Department with His Excellency the Commander-in-Chief, Lord Clyde. In this he rendered important services till the termination of the Mutiny, making drawings of the principal Forts in Oudh, and preparing a memo. of the Military strength possessed by the chief Talookdars, and their proceedings and actions during the time of the rebellion, and going in search of information when spies declined to proceed.</p>
