

The Carl Flesch Violin Competition

TO perpetuate the memory of Carl Flesch and as a tribute to his discoveries in the scientific application of violin-playing, a medal is awarded annually by the Guildhall School of Music and Drama, London. The recipient is selected at an annual competition held at the school during November.

The competition is open to violinists of every nationality who are under the age of 30

on the 1st of October of the year in question. A very high quality of violin-playing is expected and the adjudicators may withhold the award at their discretion.

The 1958 competition will take place at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama, London, on November 4. Competitors may be required to attend a Preliminary Competition on the day before.
