


#### INTRODUCTION

It was eleven months ago that we contemplated an Exhibition of Tourist Photographs of India. Every year there are held in India more than 2-3 Photographic Exhibitions but this has been the first Exhibition on a subject which is now assuming a very important character. Taking into consideration the novel subject the entries in the Exhibition have been encouraging and it is hoped that in the next Exhibition, photographers, both amateur and professional, will be able to submit more and better entries from the tourist point of view.

It has been gratifying to note the quick response to our invitation to various countries for participation in the International Tourist Posters & Film Exhibition. Many countries rushed their posters and other material by air mail at great cost and indeed the collection for the Exhibition has been one of the best ever made in this country. We are sure these posters will be greatly appreciated in India.

Entries for the Indian Tourist Poster Competition and Exhibition have not been as many as we would have liked to, though a large amount was offered as prizes. About 150 posters were received out of which only about 50 were accepted for the Exhibition. This small number may have been due to short time allowed by the someoners for the submission of entries.

Our sincere thanks are to Mrs. Vijaylakshmi Pandit and Dr. Radhakrishnan, who kindly consented to open these Exhibitions; to the Hon'ble Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri, Minister for Transport and to the Ministry of Transport for taking keen interest and giving active assistance, to Representatives of Foreign Governments for their interest and cooperation; to the various Selection Committees for their cooperation in the selection of exhibits; to the numerous exhibitors who so readily responded to our invitation; to Departments of various Central and State Governments for sending exhibits at a short notice; to the All India Fine Arts and Crafts Society for making available their expert opinion and exhibition hall; and to all others named and unnamed for various courtesies which have helped to make this Exhibition a success.

If this Exhibition has been able to create interest in tourism amongst people of India and also amongst different artists in depicting tourist objects for attracting people, it has served its purpose. I understand the Association is contemplating to keep this interest alive by holding such exhibitions quite often.


