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GLOSSARY OF VERNACULAR TERMS.

Alkhalak, a long frock reaching to the knees.

Angarkha, a large loose coat or tunic.

Asami, an office, place, appointment; (applied particularly to an appointment in an irregular cavalry regiment).

Bargir, a regular cavalry soldier whose horse and outfit is provided at the expense of another.

Bhisti, a water-carrier.

Buxaries, a class of Indian soldiers.

Dafadar, a sergeant (irregular cavalry).

Dasuti, coarse cotton cloth.

Doab, a tract of land between two rivers.

Durbar (properly *darbar*), a hall of audience; so, holding of an audience, a levée.

Ghazi, one who fights against infidels; so a Muhammadan fanatic warrior.

Golandas, native artillerymen.

Havildar, a sergeant (regular cavalry or infantry).

Jaghirda, the holder of a *jaghir* or fief.

Javel, a Pathan matchlock.

Javelchis, a corps of Pathans armed with javels.

Jemadar, a native rank corresponding to a subaltern.

Jhil, a marsh.

Jihad, a religious war of Muhammadans against infidels.

Kamrband, a waist-cloth or sash.

Khudaspa, an irregular cavalry soldier, who provides his own horse and outfit.

Kila (or *Kala*), a fort.

Kiladar, (properly *kal'a-dar*), the commandant of a fort.

Kos, a measure of distance equal to about two miles.

Kotal, a saddle-back, or ridge.

Kot-dafadar, a troop sergeant-major (irregular cavalry).

Malik, a chief or headman of a section of a Pathan tribe.

Masnad, throne.

Matti, earth; *Mooltani matti* (lit., *Mooltan earth*), the name of a dye.

Maulvi, a learned man.

Mulla, a Muhammadan priest.

Naddi, a stream or river.

Nagarchi, a kettle-drummer.

Naib-Risaldar, a brevet-risaldar.

Naik, a corporal.

Najib, a class of Indian soldiers.

Nala, a small ravine or water-course.

Nishanbardar, a standard-bearer.

Pagri, a turban.

Pakhal, a pair of large leathern bags for holding water, usually carried on bullocks.

Pakhali, the person (usually a *bhisti*), who has charge of a *pakhal*.

Pargannah, a sub-division of a district.

Ressalah (*risala*), a body of irregular horse, a troop, a regiment.

Ressaidar, a junior ressaidar.



Ressalār (*risalidar*), originally the leader of a *ressalah*; so equivalent to a captain, the commander troop.

Se syce), a groom.

Si i, a farrier.

Se , a breastwork constructed of stones.

Sardar, a chief or headman.

Sayyid, a descendant of Husain, the grandson of the Prophet.

Siladar, one who bears arms (particularly an irregular cavalryman).

Sahzada, the descendent of a king.

Shia, i. follower of Ali, the son-in-law of the Prophet.

Sibanihs, irregular soldiers employed in collecting revenue, or in police duties.

Somar, a trooper in the native cavalry.

Sowari, riding; also, equipage, suit, following.

Subadar, the governor of a province, so, an officer; a rank in infantry and in regular cavalry equivalent to a captain.

Tahsildar, a revenue collector.

Telinga, a native of Telingana, the ancient name of one of the principal kingdoms of Southern India. In former times the armies of the independent States of Southern India were extensively recruited from Telingana, and hence the term Telinga came to be used as a synonym for a "soldier."

Vakil, an agent, ambassador or representative.

Woon or Wun, a Burmese headman.

Wurdi Major, a native adjutant of irregular cavalry.

Yoma, a range of mountains (Burmese).

Zemindar, a small land-owner.

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
