In its green landscape, dotted with multi-coloured flower beds, plenty of pet animals will give you a rare feel of variable life forms surrounding us.



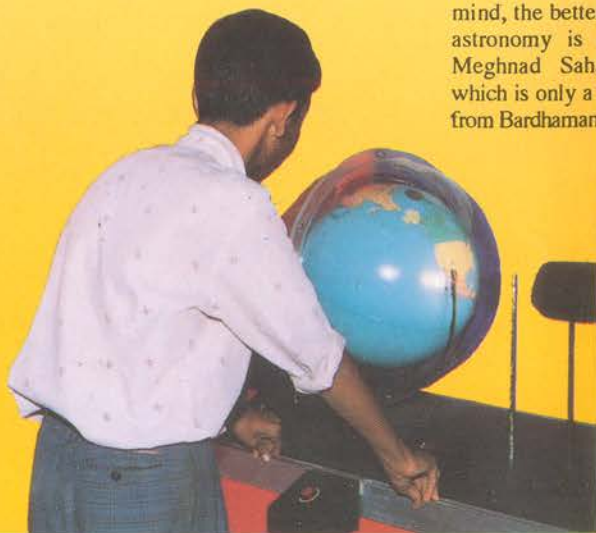
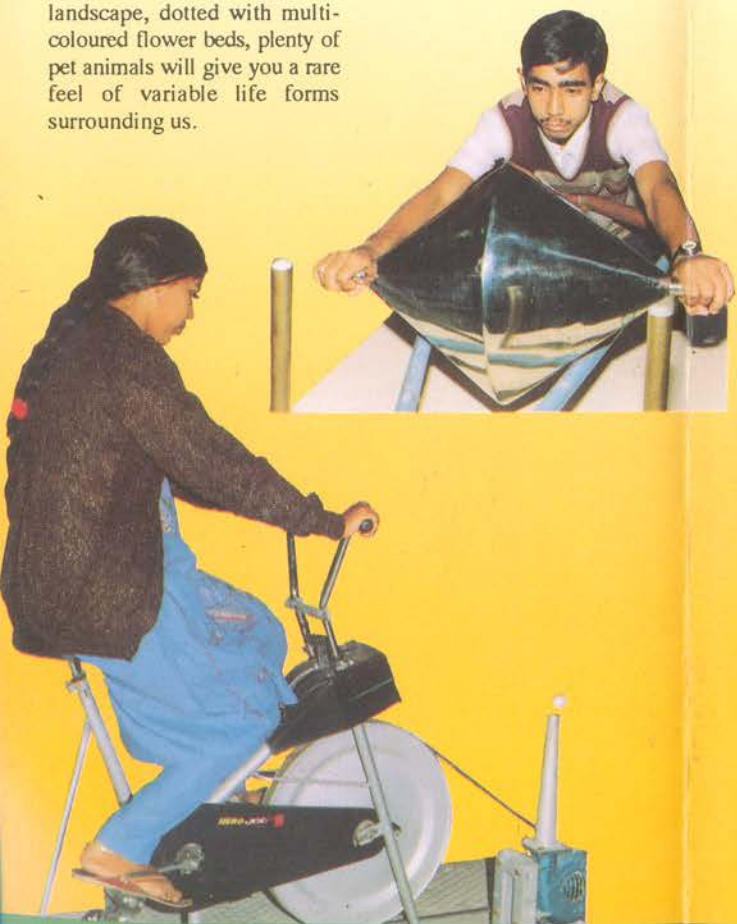

Fun with science, play with science

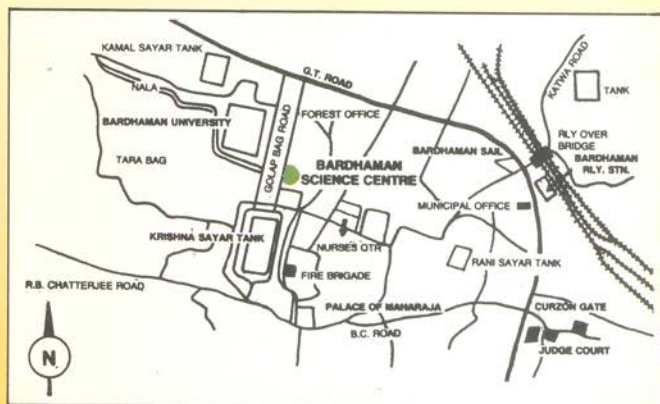
For the more inquisitive mind, the better place to learn astronomy is of course the Meghnad Saha Planetarium which is only a few steps away from Bardhaman Science Centre.





Next let us go to the world of games. The Science Centre abounds with puzzles which make mathematics easy. There are other captivating exhibits too. An array of rolling balls move in a circuitous path and perform acrobatics. They ring bells, generate electricity and play musical chimes on their way. Hot air balloons float in air. Parabolic reflectors carry whispers from one end of the park to the other end. Objects float in space defying gravity. Chemistry brings magic at home. The Science Centre unravels mysteries, explains things which other would be called supernatural.

In addition there are computers, video and film shows, teachers training, hobby centres, science fairs, science seminar and mobile science exhibitions.
